### Article 1 INTERPRETATION

#### 650.1.1 Boulevard - defined

"boulevard" means that portion of the highway at the side of or adjacent to such highway not normally used for pedestrian or vehicular traffic and exclusive of any part of the such highway coming within the definition of "sidewalk" herein.

#### 650.1.2 Crosswalk - defined

"Crosswalk" means:

- (a) that part of a highway at an intersection that is included within the connections of the lateral lines of the sidewalks on opposite sides of the highway measured from the curbs or, in the absence of curbs, from the edges of the roadway, or
- (b) any portion of a roadway at an intersection or elsewhere distinctly indicated for pedestrian crossing by signs or by lines or other markings on the surface.

#### 650.1.3 Highway - defined

"highway" - see street or highway.

#### 650.1.4 In-line skate - defined

"In-line skate" means a manufactured or assembled device consisting of an upper portion that is intended to be secured to a human foot, with a frame or chassis attached along the length of the bottom of such upper portion, with such frame or chassis holding two or more wheels that are longitudinally aligned and used to skate or glide, by means of human foot and leg power while having such device attached to each such foot or leg.

#### 650.1.5 Intersection - defined

"intersection" means the area embraced within the prolongation or connection of the lateral curb lines or, if none, then of the lateral boundary lines of two or more roadways which join one another at an angle, whether or not one crosses the other.

#### 650.1.6 Pedestrian - defined

"pedestrian" means a person afoot or a person in a wheelchair or a person in a carriage.

**650.1.7 Pedestrian crossover - defined**

"pedestrian crossover" means any portion of a roadway designated by by-law of a municipality at an intersection or elsewhere, distinctly indicated for crossing by signs the highway and lines or other markings on the surface of the roadway as prescribed by the regulations of the Highway Traffic Act.

**650.1.8 Roadway - defined**

"roadway" means that portion of a street improved, designed or ordinarily used for vehicular traffic, but does not include the shoulder.

**650.1.9 Roller skate - defined**

"roller skate" means a manufactured or assembled device consisting of a frame or shoe having clamps or straps or both for fastening, with a pair of small wheels near the toe and another pair at the heel mounted or permanently attached thereto, for skating or gliding by means of human foot or leg power.

**650.1.10 Sidewalk - defined**

"sidewalk" means that portion of a highway at the side of or adjacent to such highway normally used for pedestrian traffic only and exclusive of any part of such highway coming within the definition of "boulevards" herein.

**650.1.11 Skateboard - defined**

"skateboard" means a device consisting of a platform usually curved upwards at each end, to which are mounted or permanently attached two swiveling frames, each of which is used to support and guide a pair of small wheels, which device glides or is propelled by means of human foot or leg power.

**650.1.12 Street - highway - defined**

"street" or "highway" includes a common and public highway, street, avenue, parkway, driveway, square, place, market square, bridge, viaduct or trestle, designed and intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles.

**650.1.13 Traffic - defined**

"traffic" includes pedestrians, ridden or herded animals, vehicles and other conveyances either singly or together while using any street for the purposes of travel.

**650.1.14 Traffic control device - defined**

"traffic control device" means any sign or roadway, curb or sidewalk marking or other device erected or placed under the authority of the Council for the purpose of guiding or directing traffic.

## Article 2 GENERAL PROVISIONS

**650.2.1 Traffic control devices - obey**

Every person on in-line skates or skateboard shall obey all signals given by a Police Officer or by a traffic control device or traffic signal.

**650.2.2 In-line skaters - skateboarders - collectors - residential local roads - permitted**

In-line skaters or skateboarders shall be permitted on all collector and residential local roads as set out in Schedule 'A' of this Chapter.

**650.2.3 In-line skaters - skateboarders - under thirteen - sidewalks - permitted**

In-line skaters or skateboarders under the age of thirteen shall be permitted on sidewalks in residential zones only as set out in the City of Orillia Zoning By-law.

**650.2.4 Parks - permitted**

In-line skaters or skateboarders shall be permitted in all municipally owned parks.

**650.2.5 Trails - permitted**

In-line skaters or skateboarders shall be permitted on all municipally owned trails.

**650.2.6 Sunrise - Sunset - permitted**

An in-line skater or skateboarder may in-line skate or skateboard as set out in this Chapter after sunrise and before sunset.

**650.2.7 Arterials - non-residential local roads - prohibited**

No person shall in-line skate or skateboard on arterials and non-residential local roads in the City of Orillia as set in Schedule 'B' of this Chapter except to cross at a ninety degree angle.

**650.2.8 Sidewalks - prohibited**

Notwithstanding Section 650.2.3, no person shall in-line skate or skateboard on any sidewalk in the City of Orillia.

**650.2.9 Approved helmet - required**

No person under the age of eighteen shall in-line skate or skateboard, as set out in this Chapter, without wearing an approved Canadian Standards Association helmet and the chin strap of the helmet is securely fastened under the chin.

**650.2.10 Boardwalk - prohibited**

Notwithstanding Section 650.2.4, no person shall in-line skate or skateboard on the boardwalk in Couchiching Beach Park and Centennial Park.

### **Article 3 ENFORCEMENT**

**650.3.1 Fine - for contravention**

Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Chapter is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine or penalty as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act. By-law 1999-72, 10 May 1999.

**650.3.2 Hinder or Obstruct**

No person shall hinder or obstruct, or attempt to hinder or obstruct, any Officer exercising a power or performing a duty under this Chapter, or any person lawfully acting in aid of such an Officer. Without limiting the generality of the meaning of "hinder" or "obstruct", a person shall be deemed to have obstructed or hindered an Officer in the execution of their duties if he or she:

- (a) provides false information to an Officer; or
- (b) is alleged on reasonable and probable grounds to have contravened any of the provisions of this Chapter, and fails to identify themselves to an Officer upon request.

**650.3.3 Rebuttable presumption - identification**

In a prosecution for a contravention of this Chapter, evidence of identification shall be presumed to be correct and accurate, unless rebutted by evidence to the contrary.
