The Chair advised that the purpose of this special meeting was to discuss Recommendation 5 from the City's 2016 Waste Minimization Plan and gather feedback with respect to proposed measures for changes to the City's garbage tag user pay program in relation to increasing costs for waste collection costs.

Correspondence - Action Items

1. Manager of Water and Waste Management - re Garbage Tag User Pay Program.

Moved by Shakell-Barkey, seconded by Duncan:

THAT, further to the memo dated January 24, 2020 from the Manager of Water and Waste Management regarding the Garbage Tag User Pay Program, the Waste Management Advisory Committee provides the following comments:

- the Committee is generally in support of moving to a full user pay system
- for promotion, it is important to help people understand the importance of the environmental benefits
- implementation of the revised program over a longer period of time may provide an opportunity for increasing resources for education and ways to improve waste diversion in order to reduce the need for tags to be used
- emphasize actual cost of service (\$2.70) vs. versus the proposed price for tags (\$2.50)
- provide opportunities to sell tags in all City facilities in addition to a greater range of resellers City-wide
- price the tags at \$2.50 and allow the resellers to price at a set profit (for example – allowing a 10 cents per tag markup as opposed to offering resellers a discounted purchase price)
