### THE MILL HOUSE

#### Legal Description

The Mill House, 231 Westmount Drive South, Orillia, ON L3V 6E5

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel of tract of land and premises situate lying and being in the City of Orillia (formerly in the Township of South Orillia) in the County of Simcoe and being composed of part of the east half of Lot 10 in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Concession of the said City.

#### Reasons for Designation

The Mill House is recommended for designation for architectural and historic reasons. Built in the early 1840's by Thomas Dallas, a mill owner, it is of heavy timber frame construction. The house was originally sheathed in ship-lap siding, then later was roughcast and subsequently faced in red brick.
