Reasons for Designation

The Picnic Pavilion by the wharf in Couchiching Beach Park is recommended for designation for historical and architectural reasons. Built approximately 80 years ago the Pavilion sheltered hundreds of visitors who chose to travel north from the heat of the City to enjoy a day's outing and a picnic on the shores of Lake Couchiching. This elegant structure with its simple Doric Columns and gently curved roof compliments the Bandstand, already a heritage building. Together they give a special charm to Orillia's finest park.
