ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel of tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Orillia, in the County of Simcoe and being composed of Part of Lot 7, south side of Mississaga Street, Registered Plan 12, designated as Part 1, Reference Plan 51R-22613, being the lands in Instrument No. 30406 together with a Right-of-Way over Part 2, Reference Plan 51R-22613, being part of Lots 6 and 7, south side of Mississaga Street, Plan 12.

Reasons for Designation

This property is a typical example of the fine brick façades that still dominate Orillia's commercial core. It is the centre unit of a block built by Athenias King, Circa 1870. The upper façade is in original condition with decorative brick panels and yellow brick accents around the windows. A pressed tin ceiling adds historic character to the interior.
