#### Reasons for Designation

The house was built in 1889, and is the only example in original condition of a row of well finished brick houses built by Andrew Tait for workers at his lumber mill. It is of classical style and economical design with original red brick, windows and door. The building has projecting quoins and window trim made of yellow brick.
