Provincial Shutdown Dec. 26

As announced on Dec. 21, 2020, the Ontario government, is imposing a province-wide shutdown beginning on Dec. 26, 2020 at 12:01 a.m. The current COVID-19 Response Framework will be paused as the province-wide shutdown comes into effect. The impacts of these time-limited measures will be evaluated throughout the 14 days in Northern Ontario and 28 days in Southern Ontario to determine if it is safe to lift any restrictions or if they need to be extended. Emergency Measures By-law

In a continued effort to protect the health, safety and well-being of customers and employees in large retail/ grocery stores within the City of Orillia, on Dec. 17, 2020 Council approved an amendment to the Orillia COVID-19 Emergency Measures By-law effective Dec. 19, 2020 that implemented reduced capacity limits of approximately 50 per cent based on occupant load under the Fire Code, to a maximum of 250 people at one time, for retail/ grocery stores with a gross area greater than 20,000 sq. ft.

The reduced capacity provisions of the COVID-19 Emergency Measures By-law are in place while the City of Orillia is in the Red-Control zone or the Grey-Lockdown zone. For more information, visit orillia.ca/COVID-19.

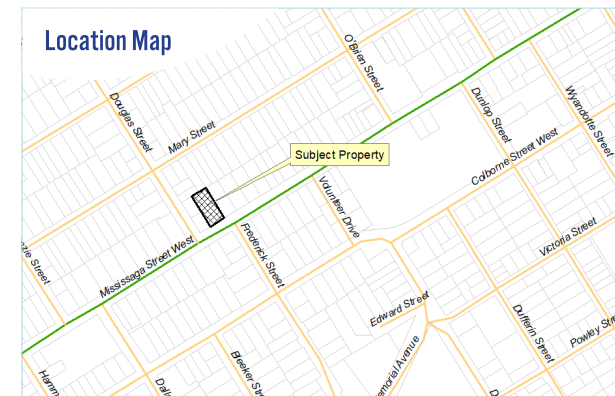
The subject property is designated "Living Area – Stable Neighbourhood" in the City's Official Plan and is currently zoned "Residential One" (R1) under the City's Zoning By-law 2014-44, as amended.

Purpose and Effect:

The purpose and effect of the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment is to permit a Four-Unit Dwelling as an additional permitted use as well as to recognize certain site-specific performance standards.

Proposal:

It is proposed that the existing building will be renovated to convert the interior space into four (4) separate residential Dwelling Units. No expansions to the building footprint or to the gross floor area are proposed. Minor alterations to the existing parking area will occur.

Proposal:

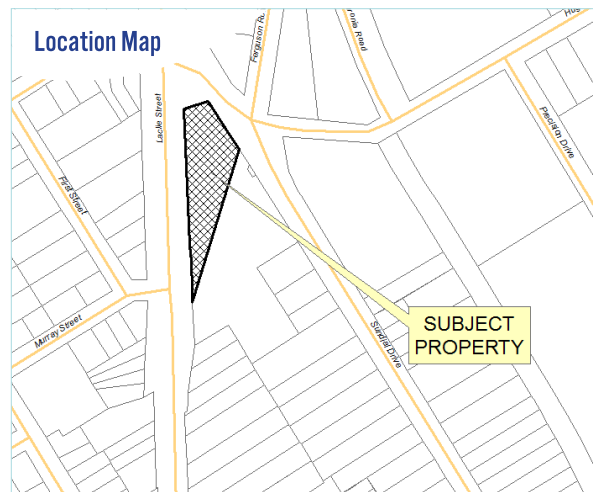
