**TAKE NOTICE** that the City of Orillia deemed the following application to amend the City's Zoning By-law 2014-44 a "Complete" application under Subsection 34 of the Planning Act on the 20th day of August 2021.

**AND TAKE NOTICE** that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Orillia will hold an **Electronic** Public Meeting on **Sept. 20, 2021 at 1 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be dealt with, to consider the following Zoning By-law Amendment Application:

The subject property is designated "Living Area – Stable Neighbourhood" in the City's Official Plan and is currently zoned "Neighbourhood Commercial" (C2) under the City's Zoning By-law 2014-44, as amended.

### Purpose and Effect:

The purpose and effect of the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment is to permit a Veterinary Clinic within the existing commercial building and recognize existing deficient landscaped open space and landscape buffer strip areas.

### Proposal:

It is proposed that the existing building will be renovated to convert the interior space into a Veterinary Clinic. No expansions to the building footprint or to the gross floor area are proposed.

**PLEASE NOTE** that due to the physical distancing requirements imposed during the current COVID-19 pandemic, this Public Meeting will be held **electronically**. **IF YOU INTEND TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ELECTRONIC PUBLIC MEETING you are required to register with the Deputy Clerk (mwilliams@orillia.ca, 705-325-5408) by no later than noon on Sept. 19, 2021. Upon registration, the necessary information required to join the meeting will be provided to you. Written submissions prior to the meeting date are required from those parties intending to participate in the meeting, in order that your comments are on record in the event of any technical difficulties.** Note that the Applicant and/or their Agent are not required to pre-register with the Deputy Clerk. **ANY PERSON OR AGENCY** who is of the opinion that holding the hearing as an electronic hearing is likely to cause them significant prejudice, may make a submission to the Deputy Clerk, in writing by delivery to the City drop slot or by email to [mwilliams@orillia.ca](mailto:mwilliams@orillia.ca) on or before noon on Sept. 19, 2021, and if City of Orillia Council is satisfied that holding the hearing as an electronic hearing is likely to cause the party significant prejudice then the hearing will be rescheduled as an oral hearing. If a person or agency does not make a submission to the Deputy Clerk in this manner by noon on Sept. 19, 2021, and the person or agency does not participate in the hearing in accordance with this Notice, then the Public Meeting may proceed without the party's participation and the party will not be entitled to any further notice in the proceeding.

## City of Orillia Voting Method: HAVE YOUR SAY

**Council Committee, at its meeting held on Aug. 23, 2021, discussed alternative voting methods for the 2022 Municipal Election to be held on Oct. 24, 2022.**

Following discussion, Committee adopted a recommendation to continue with the use of in-person polls with paper ballots as the voting method for the 2022 Municipal Election. Ballots would be counted using optical scanning vote tabulators.

This recommendation will be presented to Council for ratification on Sept. 20, 2021.
