Getting **fully** vaccinated is the **only** way we get through this pandemic

As of Wednesday, June 23rd, all Orillia residents who received their first COVID-19 vaccine dose on or before May 30th will be able to book their accelerated second vaccine appointment.

Starting the week of June 28th, all Ontarians aged 18 and over who have received their first dose will be able to book their second dose appointment at least 28 days after the first dose.

Please book your second dose as soon as possible.

If you haven't received your first vaccine dose yet, it is critical you do so. Getting vaccinated is safe and effective. It protects you, your family, your friends and the whole community and will help us get back to the people, places and activities we love.
