TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Orillia will hold a Public Meeting on **Nov. 4, 2019 at 6:30 p.m.** in the Council Chamber, Orillia City Centre, 50 Andrew St. S., to consider a municipally initiated Zoning By-law Amendment.

### Purpose and Effect:

The purpose and effect of the Zoning By-law Amendment (City File No. D14-884) is to effect housekeeping amendments to the City's Comprehensive Zoning By-law 2014-44 to improve and clarify various provisions. **The housekeeping amendments apply to all properties in the City.**

The amendment also includes two site-specific mapping changes shown on the Location Map below, as follows:

#### 1382 Wilson Point Road

Add a Holding Provision (H19) to the Zoning of the property which will ensure development of the property occurs in accordance with technical studies that have been completed; and

#### The former Oak Street Road Allowance (Plan 292)

Add zoning to this property, which was previously a City road allowance. The property will be zoned to match the adjoining property.

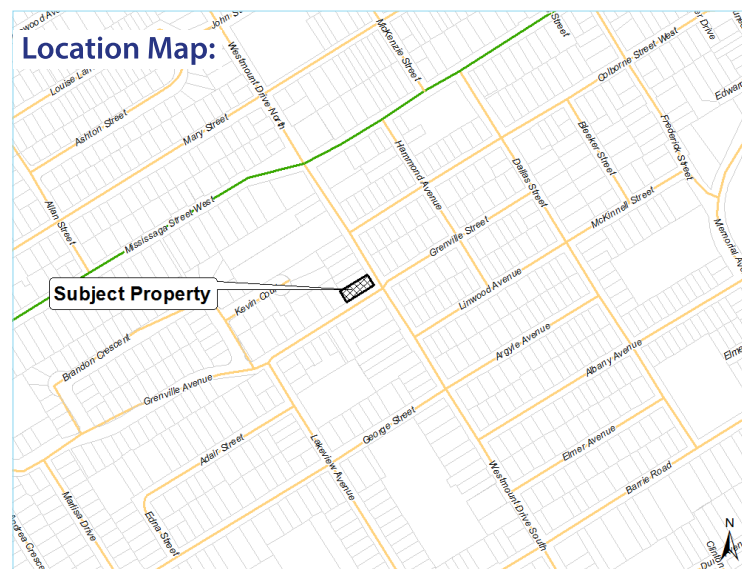
### Proposal:

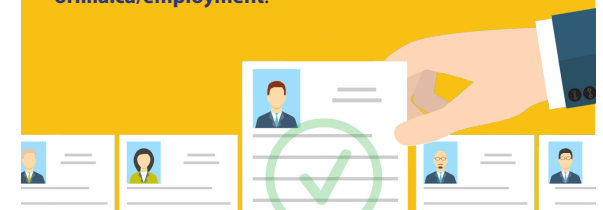
