



Highlights from the Council Chamber

Public Meeting/Council Meeting – Nov. 26, 2018

Below are highlights of what Council adopted at its meetings on Monday, Nov. 26, 2018.

The following includes changes or recorded votes to recommendations from the Nov. 19, 2018 Council Committee meeting. The wording below does not represent the exact wording of the motion and is meant as highlights of what was adopted.

Public Meeting:

- Council deferred Draft Official Plan Amendment and Zoning By-law Amendment for Application No's. D09-199 and D14-877 (Waterfront Redevelopment Area) for future consideration by the 2018-2022 Council. Another Public Meeting was scheduled on December 21, 2018.

Council Meeting:

The grant request from Crime Stoppers of Simcoe Dufferin Muskoka was received as information.

- Council reconsidered Resolution Number 2018-47 from the March 5, 2018 Council meeting with respect to the fifth paragraph of Clause 10 of Council Committee Report 2018-4 regarding tax relief for the Building Hope Initiative's 20 Supportive Housing units at 75 Queen Street East as follows:
 - Council provided tax relief for the property at 75 Queen Street if the property does not meet MPAC's requirements for an exemption, for a period of ten years, provided the organization and the County of Simcoe enter into a Municipal Capital Facilities Agreement, the aforementioned tax relief shall apply only to the portion of the property described in the Municipal Capital Facilities Agreement.

- Further to the public meeting of Council held on November 26, 2018, Council approved the Draft Official Plan Amendment and Zoning By-law Amendment (By-law Numbers 2018-99, 2018-100 and 2018-101) for Application No's. D09-200 and D14-879 (Source Protection Conformity and Housekeeping Amendments).
- **A recorded vote was requested on the following bylaw:**
 THAT By-law Number 2018-103, being a by-law to authorize the sale of lands encroaching onto the Dougall Canal, be now introduced and read a first, second and third time today.
This by-law has the effect of authorizing the sale of land that is encroaching onto the Dougall Canal to the adjacent property owners as set out in the CIP memo dated November 19, 2018 from the Economic Development Department.
Carried (unanimous)

The following are recommendations from Council Committee on Nov. 19, 2018 that were adopted by Council with no changes Nov. 26, 2018:

- The report regarding the operational impacts of parked vehicles on Grenville Avenue during winter daytime snow removal operations was received as information.
- A "No Parking Anytime" restriction was implemented along the north side of Grenville Avenue from the east intersection of Brandon Crescent to Mississaga Street West. Traffic and Parking Regulation By-law Number 2007-55 was amended as set out in Schedule "B" of the report.
- The report regarding traffic signals at Orchard Point Road and Highway 12 was received as information.
- A "No Parking Anytime" restriction was implemented on the east side of Mississaga Street West from 180 metres south of Walker Avenue to a point 70 metres south. Traffic and Parking By-law Number 2007-55 was amended as set out in Schedule "B" of the report.
- The report regarding the Northern Heat Rib Series at J.B. Tudhope Memorial Park was received as information.
- The report regarding taxation and Common Elements Condominiums was received as information.
- The report regarding a summary of Bill 36, the *Ontario Cannabis Statute Law Amendment Act* was received as information.
- The report regarding an update with respect to the outcome of the Fire Arbitration Awards was received as information. Chapter 208 of the City of Orillia Municipal Code - Sickness and Disability Benefit Plan was amended to incorporate the Arbitrator's award to increase the long-term disability benefit for the Orillia Professional Fire Fighters Association (OPFFA) employee group. Chapter 208 of the City of Orillia Municipal Code - Sickness and Disability Benefit Plan was amended for a trial period of three years to reflect the changes required due to the Arbitrator's award of the 24-hour shift for suppression fire fighters of the OPFFA employee group.
- The budget allocation for the City Centre Heating, Ventilation and Air-Conditioning (HVAC) Improvements project was increased by \$34,000 over the approved budget of \$50,000, for a total budget of \$84,000. The additional funding was appropriated from the City Centre Reserve in the amount of \$34,000.

- The cost of emergency light post replacement in the building parking lot, and Heating, Ventilation and Air-Conditioning (HVAC) repairs at the building located at 2 Hunter Valley Road in the amount of \$44,604 was funded from the 2 Hunter Valley Road Reserve.
- The 2019 Council Meeting Schedule be adopted as set out in Schedule "A" of the report. Chapter 12 of the City of Orillia Municipal Code - Council Committee - Procedure was amended to allow Council Committee meetings to occur during the day at 2:00 p.m. for a trial period of one year.
