



Highlights from the Council Chamber

Council Meeting – March 2, 2020

Below are highlights of what Council adopted at its meeting on Monday, March 2, 2020.

The following includes changes or recorded votes to recommendations from the Feb. 24, 2020 Council Committee meeting. The wording below does not represent the exact wording of the motion and is meant as highlights of what was adopted.

- As recommended by Principles Integrity, the remuneration of Councillor Cipolla, having been found to have breached the City of Orillia's Code of Conduct, was suspended for a period of five days. The report will be posted on the City of Orillia's website for public access.
- **A recorded vote was requested on the following:**
An exemption to Chapter 938 of the City of Orillia Municipal Code - Noise be granted for the purposes of permitting outdoor music until 1:00 a.m. on June 21, 2020 for a wedding reception at the Stephen Leacock Museum.

- The report from Councillor Emond regarding the OSUM Conference held from May 1 - 3, 2019 was received as information.
- Further to the Public Meeting of Council held on February 10, 2020, Council approved the Draft Plan of Subdivision Application No. 43T-19001 (Paul Federico Orillia (144 Elgin St) Ventures Inc. - 144 Elgin Street), including the Conditions of Approval for Final Approval as set out in Schedule "B" of the Supplementary Memo dated February 21, 2020. Council approved the Plan of Common Elements Condominium 43CD-19001 (Paul Federico Orillia (144 Elgin St) Ventures Inc. - 144 Elgin Street), including the Conditions of Approval for Final Approval as set out in Schedule "C" of the Supplementary Memo dated February 21, 2020. Council approved the Application for Zoning By-law Amendment D14-882 (Paul Federico Orillia (144 Elgin St) Ventures Inc. - 144 Elgin Street) as set out in Schedule "D" of the Supplementary Memo dated February 21, 2020. In accordance with subsection 45 (1.4) of the *Planning Act*, Minor Variance applications may be applied for before the second anniversary of the passage of Zoning By-law Amendment By-law Number 2020-13 notwithstanding subsection 45 (1.3) of the *Planning Act*.
- Further to the Public Meeting of Council held on February 10, 2020, Council approved Zoning By-law Amendment Application No. D14-888 (William Thornton, 309 Colborne Street West) in accordance with the Zoning By-law Amendment set

out in the Supplementary Memo dated February 25, 2020. In accordance with subsection 37 (17) of the *Planning Act*, no further notice of the amended Zoning By-law Amendment is required to be given due to the minor nature of the changes that occurred following the Public Meeting of Council held on February 10, 2020.

The following are recommendations from Council Committee on Feb. 24, 2020 that were adopted by Council with no changes on March 2, 2020:

- The report regarding the findings from the economic impact study of Orillia Soldiers' Memorial Hospital (OSMH) conducted by urbanMetrics inc. was received as information. A copy of the economic impact study was forwarded to the OSMH Future Hospital Steering Committee to assist in their deliberations to select a site for the future hospital.
- The Farmers' Market Management Committee was reconstituted as the Farmers' Market Advisory Committee. Chapter 101 of the City of Orillia Municipal Code - Farmers' Market Management Committee was repealed and replaced as set out in Schedule "A" to the report. Policy 1.9.1.2. - Farmers' Market - Operations - Terms and Conditions was amended accordingly.
- The request from Kayak-ity-Yak to operate a non-motorized water vehicle rental business with a fixed kiosk at J.B. Tudhope Memorial Park was referred to staff for further review and recommendation with respect to potential locations within the park suitable for a one-year trial for a seasonal fixed kiosk structure. The concept of incorporating a permanent structure for the operation of a non-motorized water vehicle rental business in Couchiching Beach Park or Centennial Park was forwarded to TLA Studio for consideration as part of the Waterfront Parkland Design.
- The Mayor and Clerk were authorized to execute an Industrial Waste Surcharge Agreement with Costco Wholesale Canada Ltd., effective March 16, 2020, or later at the discretion of the City.
- Mid Ontario Disposal (Division of Doug Roe Enterprises Ltd.) was awarded the Solid Waste Collection Contract ESO-SWD-19-4 for an eight-year term commencing July 1, 2020 at the negotiated pricing proposed with an estimated annual contract value of \$1,724,720 plus HST and with the amended contract terms as outlined in the report. The Mayor and Clerk were authorized to execute the Solid Waste Collection Contract.
- \$195,000 was authorized for legal and consulting fees related to the Waterfront Redevelopment Project to be allocated from the Land Acquisition Reserve.
