



Highlights from the Council Chamber

Council Meeting – July 19, 2021

Below are highlights of what Council adopted at its meeting on Monday, July 19, 2021.

The following includes changes or recorded votes to recommendations from the July 19, 2021 Council Committee meeting. The wording below does not represent the exact wording of the motion and is meant as highlights of what was adopted.

- **A recorded vote was requested for the following:**
As recommended in confidential Report HR-21-4 the exempt employee group receive the following increases as set out in Option 1 of the report:
 - 1.65% Cost of Living Adjustment, plus adjustment, effective January 1, 2021.
 - 1.5% Cost of Living Adjustment, plus adjustment, effective January 1, 2022, 2023 and 2024.

The supplementary Report DSE-21-23 regarding the preferred design option for the purpose of completing the detailed design for the Terry Fox Circle was received as information.

The grant requests from the Catholic Family Services of Simcoe County and the Orillia Cricket Club was received as information.

- The report from the Grants Committee regarding a Starry Night Activity Update was received as information.
- Further to the Public Meeting of Council held on June 28, 2021, Council approved the Draft Plan of Subdivision 43T-20002 (2628251 Ontario Ltd. - 679

Atherley Road) including the proposed Conditions of Draft Approval for Final Approval as set out in Schedule “B” of the Supplementary Memo. Council approved the application for Zoning By-law Amendment D14-897 (2628251 Ontario Inc. - 679 Atherley Road) as set out in Schedule “C” of the Supplementary Memo. In accordance with subsection 45 (1.4) of the *Planning Act*, Minor Variance applications may be applied for before the second anniversary of the passage of Zoning By-law Amendment 2020-69 notwithstanding subsection 45 (1.3) of the *Planning Act*.

The following are recommendations from Council Committee on June 21, 2021 that were adopted by Council with no changes on June 28, 2021:

- Staff was directed to work with Lindsay and Cory Harrison for the placement and installation of a Little Free Library at J.B. Tudhope Memorial Park. The City will provide a plaque for dedication as set out in Option 1 of confidential Report EIS-21-11. Staff will work to formalize an agreement with Lindsay and Cory Harrison for the responsibility and requirements of the Little Free Library's upkeep and maintenance.
- A pilot project for a litter clean-up crew at a cost of approximately \$40,000 will be included for consideration as part of the 2022 Budget deliberations. As part of the budget submission, staff is directed to prepare a report that includes the following elements:
 - A review and evaluation of problematic areas prior to the deployment of the clean-up blitz;
 - The process and procedure for involving and reporting significant accumulation to the City's Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for enforcement purposes;
 - The cost and value of hiring seasonal Parks staff earlier and retention of seasonal Winter Control staff until the end of May to aid in the blitz efforts; and
 - The methodology for evaluating the success of the clean-up blitz.
- The supplementary Report DSE-21-23 regarding the preferred design option for the purpose of completing the detailed design for the Terry Fox Circle was received as information.
- The Orillia Farmers' Market Manager and Administrative Support - Committee Support were designated as the staff resources for the extension of the 2021 Orillia Food Committee Pilot Project. \$3,829 will be allocated from Operating Contingency to fund the staff resources for the Orillia Food Committee Pilot Project. Any future financial implications for the resourcing of the Orillia Food Committee, pending the outcome of the Governance Review, was referred to the 2022 Budget deliberations.
- The City Policy Manual was amended for housekeeping purposes as set out in Schedule "A" to the report. The following City Policies were repealed:

- The feasibility of amending Chapter 785 of the City of Orillia Municipal Code - Parks Regulation to permit shade structures within parks including beach areas.
