Special Council Meeting – July 30, 2021

Below are highlights of what Council adopted at its meeting on Friday, July 30, 2021.

The wording below does not represent the exact wording of the motion and is meant as highlights of what was adopted.

- The confidential report regarding the preferred proponent and Agreement of Purchase and Sale with respect to the Waterfront Redevelopment Project was received.
- **A recorded vote was requested for the following:**
The report regarding the preferred proponent and the Agreement of Purchase and Sale with respect to the Waterfront Redevelopment Project was received.

- Ainley and Associates Ltd. was authorized to proceed with the detailed design of the duct structures and related works required to accommodate burying of the existing overhead power lines as part of the existing Centennial Drive Improvement Project as depicted in Option 1 on Schedule “A” to the report at an estimated cost of \$75,000 plus HST. Staff was directed to report to Council Committee to provide options that may be considered to utilize potential cost recovery mechanisms whereby some or all of the costs of burying the existing overhead power lines may be apportioned to adjacent benefitting property owners. Staff were authorized to request Hydro One to complete their component of the detailed design in order to provide an accurate cost estimate.
- **A recorded vote was requested for the following by-law:**
THAT By-law Number 2021-77, a by-law to confirm an Agreement of Purchase and Sale with FRAM Building Group Ltd. for 70 Front Street North and to authorize the sale thereof, be enacted.
