



## Highlights from the Council Chamber

### **Special Council Meeting re Centennial Drive Phase 1 Reconstruction, Delegation of Authority and Housekeeping/Appointment By-laws – August 12, 2022**

Below are highlights of what was adopted by Council at the Special Council Meeting re Centennial Drive Phase 1 Reconstruction, Delegation of Authority and Housekeeping/Appointment By-laws meeting on Friday, August 12, 2022.

- Council authorized a \$1,645,000 increase in funding for the Centennial Drive Improvement Capital Project - Phase 1 from \$10,600,000 to \$12,245,000. The Capital Project funding increase was appropriated as follows:
  - \$1,398,250 from the Wastewater Asset Management Reserve Fund
  - \$146,750 from the Water Asset Management Reserve Fund
  - \$100,000 from the Gas Tax Obligatory Reserve FundStaff were authorized to execute a Change Order to the Centennial Drive Improvement Project - Phase 1 Contract to enable construction to be completed.
- The report regarding the restricted acts of Council after Nomination Day - Lame Duck provisions was received. Chapter 251 of the City of Orillia Municipal Code - Delegated Authority was amended to provide delegated authority to the Chief Administrative Officer and City Solicitor with respect to the actions set out in the *Municipal Act*, 2001, Subsection 275(3) (c) during the period which Council may be restricted from certain acts, as set out in Section 275 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001.
