Highlights from the Council Chamber

Council Meeting – September 19, 2022

Below are highlights of what Council adopted at its meeting on Monday, September 19, 2022.

The following includes changes or recorded votes to recommendations from the September 12, 2022 Council Committee meeting. The wording below does not represent the exact wording of the motion and is meant as highlights of what was adopted.

- The correspondence dated August 12, 2022 from the Attorney General regarding judicial interim release in Ontario was received and forwarded to the Orillia Police Services Board for further comment.
- Further to the deputation from Linda Goodall and Michael Bells, a request of \$16,500 was approved and provided to the Lighthouse Shelter to assist with the provision of an extreme weather night-time warming centre during the winter of 2022-23 for Orillia's homeless. The funds were allocated from the 2022 Operating Contingency Account. The Lighthouse Shelter was requested to submit a report to Council in June 2023 outlining the operational statistics and how the funding was spent. An additional request will be forwarded to the 2023 Budget deliberations so that a contribution for an extreme weather night-time warming centre be considered for future budgets.
- **A recorded vote was requested for the following:**
The report regarding options for Raising the Roof - Chez Toit to provide additional parking spaces associated with the proposed redevelopment of the Canada Post property at 25 Peter Street North was received as information.

The following are recommendations from Council Committee on September 12, 2022 that were adopted by Council with no changes on September 19, 2022.

- The Confidential Report regarding a Hall of Fame complaint was received as information.
- The Confidential Report regarding options for the naming of two ball diamonds located within Kitchener Park was received as information. Staff were directed to review the various policies related to naming/renaming of all corporate assets and report back to Council on a new corporate naming policy.

- Staff were authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Orillia Sport Council for stewardship of the Athlete of the Year. Policy 7.3.3.1. - Athlete of the Year will be amended as set out in Schedule "A" of Report CS-22-34 from the Corporate Services Department. Policy 7.2.2.4. - Temporary Advertising Policy will be amended as set out in Schedule "B" of Report CS-22-34 from the Corporate Services Department.
- Chapter 251 of the City of Orillia Municipal Code - Delegated Authority was amended to provide delegated authority to the General Manager of Development Services and Engineering or in his/her absence the Senior Planner with respect to Subsection 40 of the *Planning Act*.
- Policy 5.7.1.6. - Electronic Monitoring of Employees at Work was adopted as set out in Schedule "A" of Report HR-22-06 from the Human Resources Department.
- Policy 5.7.1.4. - COVID-19 Prevention Policy was amended as set out in Schedule "A" of Report CAO-22-02 from the Chief Administrative Office.
