



Highlights from the Council Chamber

Special Council Committee Meeting – Oct. 31, 2022

Below is a snapshot of what Council Committee recommended at its meeting held on Monday, Oct. 31. Please note: The wording below does not represent the exact wording of the motion and is meant as highlights.

Please note that Council Committee recommendations are subject to Council ratification and can be pulled for discussion and change in direction at regular Council, which is scheduled for immediately following the Special Council Committee on Oct. 31, 2022.

- The report from the Corporate Services Department regarding a standard approach to the application of rates for Not-for-Profit entities that lease municipal real property was received. Policy 1.7.1.1. - Real Property will be amended as set out in Schedule "A" to the report.
- The feasibility of implementing a pedestrian crossing treatment across Coldwater Road West between Emily Street and Cameron Street was referred to Budget Committee for consideration as part of the 2023 Budget deliberations.
- The feasibility of establishing transit fares for seniors, as well as options and opportunities to increase ridership on the City's transit system including potential programs/incentives/initiatives available via the cOnnect Transit Pass system, transit fare opportunities and increased marketing campaigns was referred to Budget Committee for consideration as part of the 2023 Budget deliberations.
- The feasibility and costs associated with severing the City-owned property located at 26 Benner Street to create a lot for affordable housing was referred to Budget Committee as part of the 2023 Budget deliberations.
- The report from the Corporate Services Department regarding the audited financial statements for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2021 was received as information.
