

COUNCIL Highlights

Regular Council Meeting – May 21, 2024

Below are highlights of what Council Committee recommended when it convened on Monday, May 21, 2024. The recommendations are subject to ratification at the next scheduled Council meeting of June 3, 2024 unless the item is pulled and ratified on May 21, 2024. The wording is meant to be highlights and does not reflect the actual motion.

- Policy 1.3.1.5. - Order of Orillia and Orillia Hall of Fame Award Programs was adopted as set out in Schedule "A" to Report CS-24-16. The Commemorative Awards Selection Panel was directed to report back on the feasibility of the committee, rather than Council removing a recipient from the Hall of Fame. The report is also to consider a Youth category for the Order of Orillia.
- Staff was directed to construct 26 additional on-street parallel metered parking spaces and two accessible parking spaces as set out in Schedule "B" to report DSE-24-01, with the exception that the 17 new paid on-street parallel parking spaces situated along Colborne Street East and West be priced at the on-street low utilization rate of \$1.75 per hour. The five-minute free parking spaces installed in front of the Canada Post Office on Peter Street South will remain at this time. Staff was directed to implement the Passport Parking App on the Colborne Street parking spaces.
- The report regarding the feasibility of reducing the parking rate at Temporary Municipal Parking Lot 15 (20 Front Street South) from \$3.00 per hour to \$2.00 per hour was received as information.
- Chapter 459 of the City of Orillia Municipal Code - User Fees - Environment and Infrastructure Services - Water and Wastewater was amended as set out in Schedule "A" of report EIS-24-08.
- Staff was authorized to amend and rescope Capital Project Number 03292 - 2024 Fleet Additions to remove the Automated Pothole Repair Machine. The approved Capital Project Number 03292 - 2024 Fleet Additions, in the amount of \$600,000, was re-allocated as follows:
 - Asphalt Combination Patching Trailer
 - Roads Operations Crew Pick Up Trucks
 - Operations Response Supervisor/Management Pick Up Trucks
 - Flail Mower Tractor Attachment
- Policy 7.2.2.4. - Temporary Advertising was amended as set out in Schedule "A" of report CS-24-19. The user fees listing in Facilities and Parks of Chapter 456 of the City of Orillia Municipal Code - Recreation, Youth and Culture was amended as set out in Schedule "B" of report CS-24-19.

The following was adopted at the Council meeting on Monday, May 21, 2024. The wording is meant to be a highlight and does not represent the exact motion adopted:

- Council adopted the recommendations as set out in the Consent Agenda for the regular meeting of Council held on Monday, May 21, 2024.
- The County of Simcoe was requested to install additional landscaping together with fencing on the temporary housing site. The balance of the \$100,000 allocation for the Supportive Rapid Re-Housing Program, in the amount of \$27,188, appropriated from the Affordable Housing Reserve, will be offered to the County of Simcoe to offset the costs of the installation of landscaping and fencing.

COUNCIL Highlights

- Staff were directed to develop recommendations as part of the Parks, Recreation and Culture Master Plan update with respect to the feasibility of amending Schedule "A" of Chapter 456 of the City of Orillia Municipal Code - User Fees - Recreation, Youth and Culture, and Policy 7.1.6.3. - User Fees to establish a partial park rental fee and security deposit.
