NOTICE OF COMPLETION

BACKGROUND

In April 2017, the City of Orillia initiated a Schedule 'C' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) to facilitate improvements to Front Street from Queen Street East to Neywash Street and Neywash Street from Front Street to Lacie Street. The purpose of this undertaking is to address the deteriorated condition of the subject segments of Front Street and Neywash Street and to provide improvements to existing servicing infrastructure.

Following the completion of Public Information Centre No. 2 (March 28, 2018) and the receipt of input from interested parties, the City of Orillia has selected Design Option 1 as the Preferred Design which proposes a three lane urban cross-section with 3.5 m wide lanes from Lacie St. to King St. and a four lane urban cross-section with 3.35 m wide lanes from King St. to Queen St. E. Improvements will also be made to intersections, servicing and landscaping. The existing trunk sanitary sewer will be relocated from the waterfront area to Front St. to eliminate design and future development constraints for Centennial Drive and to improve the development potential of the waterfront area.

ENVIRONMENTAL STUDY REPORT

In accordance with Phase 4 of the Schedule 'C' Municipal Class EA process an Environmental Study Report (ESR) has been prepared to document the Class EA process completed for this undertaking and by this Notice is being placed in the public record for a 30 day public review and comment period. 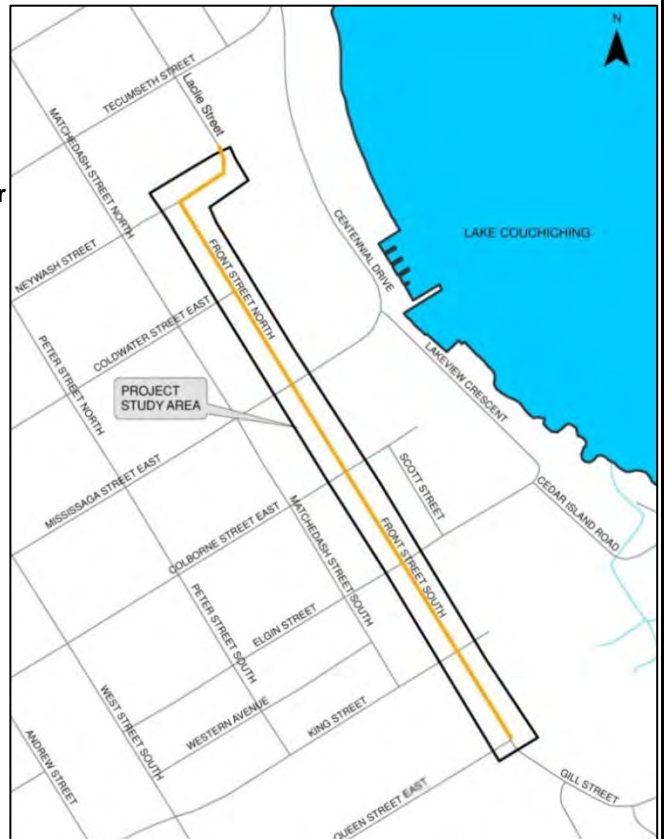
