Part 1, Draft Plan 51R-XXXX Approx. 0.89 ha	The area subject to the lease comprises the entirety of the parcel, as shown on the Consent Sketch dated September 12, 2023. The original lease, dated October 19, 2004, was executed between the Lessee and the former Owner. The term of the new lease is summarized as follows:

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Original Lease: Period of twenty (20) years, commenced on December 1, 2004 and expiring on December 1, 2024;• options to renew: for a further periods of five (5) years.
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REASONS: The application conforms with the requirements of the City of Orillia Zoning By-law, the City of Orillia Official Plan, a Plan of Subdivision is not required, and satisfies the requirements of all commenting agencies.

NOTICE OF THE LAST DAY FOR APPEALING TO THE ONTARIO LANDS TRIBUNAL

The applicant, the Minister, a specified person or public body may, not later than **20 days** after the giving of notice is completed, appeal the decision or any condition imposed by the Committee or appeal both the decision and any condition to the Tribunal by filing with the Secretary-Treasurer of the municipality a notice of appeal setting out the reasons for the appeal, accompanied by the fee charged under the *Ontario Lands Tribunal Act, 2017*. 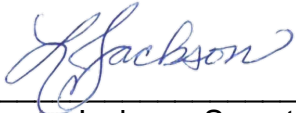

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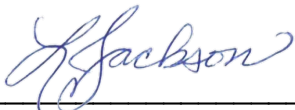
SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

Pursuant to the Planning Act, as amended, all conditions imposed must be fulfilled within Two (2) years from the date of the sending of the Decision or the application is deemed to be refused.

It is a requirement that all conditions imposed be fulfilled prior to the granting of this consent before the issuance of the Certificate of Official under a Form 2 by the Secretary-Treasurer.

Standard Conditions:

2. That the applicant shall pay the required fee for issuance of the Certificate of Official (2023 fee - \$69.00).
