The Corporation of the City of Orillia has various openings for the positions of Summer Parks Maintenance workers. Hours of work will include evenings and weekends for all positions.

DUTIES

- Flower bed preparation, installation and ongoing care.
- Turf mowing, line trimming, litter picking
- Ball diamond maintenance
- Garbage and recycling collection throughout the parks
- Washroom and parks outbuilding cleaning and maintenance
- Other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Grade 12 or equivalent.
- Strong customer service, organizational and decision making skills.
- Proven ability to work independently, with minimal supervision
- Must possess a valid Class 'G' Ontario driver's licence with an acceptable driver's abstract.
- Experience operating equipment such as trucks, riding mowers, and power tools, hand tools, cleaning and building maintenance tools.
- Previous experience as a park worker would be an asset.
