THAT Report PSB-2020-10 be received;

AND THAT the Orillia Police Services Board adopt the following three key priorities for the Ontario Provincial Police - Orillia Detachment 2020-2022 Action Plan:

1. Property Crime - a focus on prevention for theft, fraud, and break and enter occurrences.
2. Violent Crime - a focus on domestic violence/assault.

3. Community Engagement - a focus on police visibility in the community including foot patrols, community mobilization unit, situation table, etc.;

AND THAT in order of importance, the Orillia Police Services Board cite the following “Big 4” causal factors that are perceived to be priorities in the community:

1. Distracted driving/operation
2. Impaired driving/operation
3. Speed/aggressive driving/operation
4. Lack of seatbelt/safety equipment;

AND THAT the Orillia Police Services Board cite the following social and/or public health issues (non-police) that are perceived to be the root cause issues of crime/disorder in the community:

1. Mental health
2. Addictions
3. Socio/economic issues (i.e. access to affordable housing);

AND THAT the Board Secretary be directed to forward the key priorities to the Orillia OPP Detachment Commander for inclusion in the Ontario Provincial Police - Orillia Detachment 2020-2022 Action Plan by December 14, 2020.
