Access to Markets

- Orillia is located approximately one hour from the GTA at the crossroads of the north/south Highway 11/400 and east/west Highway 12.
- The Lake Simcoe Regional Airport, with passenger, freight, and full Canada Customs service, is just 10 minutes away.
- Based on customer origin research, Orillia's
 customers come from a broad geographic region
 (trade area) which includes Parry Sound, Huntsville,
 Bracebridge, Penetanguishene, Midland and south
 to the City of Barrie.
- This trade area is home to approximately 200,000 permanent residents, which is expected to grow by 23% by 2031.
- This area also encompasses approximately 150,000 additional seasonal residents.
- The Growth Plan for the Greater Golden Horseshoe as amended predicts that Orillia's population will grow by approximately 34% by 2031.

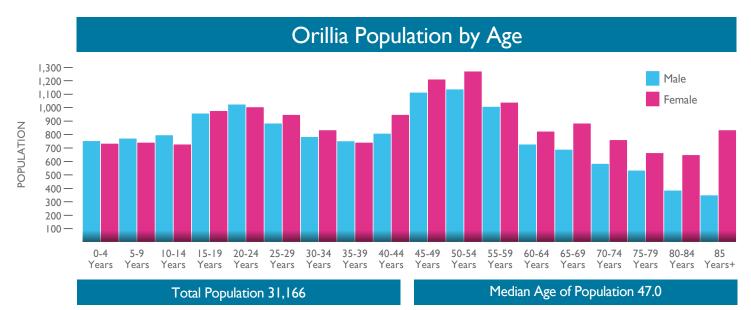
