

NOTICE: Curbside Collection Routes Altered in Orillia

Due to the ongoing growth and development in the west-end of Orillia, the curbside collection routes for Tuesday and Wednesday are being altered to better balance out the collection times. Tuesday's existing route is very long and the City's collection contractor (Mid Ontario Disposal) is finding that they are regularly finishing the curbside collection in this area late. To accommodate the part of Tuesday's route that is moving into Wednesday, and to ensure collection is balanced throughout the week, a portion of Wednesday's route is moving into Thursday's collection route. One further change is occurring on Louise Lane, which is moving from Tuesday's to Monday's collection route given it is much easier for the collection trucks to collect Louise Lane and Ashton Street at the same time on Monday's run. The following map shows all the changes that are taking effect **the week of Monday, Dec. 3, 2018**.

Please note that collection times will change on the Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday runs so please ensure all your garbage, green bin, yard waste and recycling boxes are at the curb by 7 a.m. on your scheduled collection day to ensure collection. For example, if you are used to seeing your materials collected in the afternoon on your collection day, they may now be collected much earlier in the day so please have everything out by 7 a.m. Please call the Waste Diversion Site at 705-325-3522 should you have any questions.
