The Environment and Infrastructure Services Department has prepared an Environmental Emergency (E2) Plan per the Ministry of Environment and Climate Change Canada requirement to ensure safety measures for the storage of Liquefied Chlorine Gas at the Water Filtration Plant. Liquefied Chlorine Gas is used for the treatment of drinking water to kill disease-causing pathogens, such as bacteria, viruses, and protozoans.

The plan provides information on Liquefied Chlorine Gas, preventative and control measures in place for its storage as well as risk management and response measures to address potential emergency situations.

Members of the Public would be notified of an emergency immediately by:

- Formal Notification – Radio, Social Media, City of Orillia website
