Program

The Recreation Financial Assistance Program provides subsidized access rates for monthly FUN Passes for up to 100 residents of Orillia per year, as well as subsidized rates for All-Access Day Passes for Social Service Agencies and their clients.

Please complete this form to apply to the City of Orillia Recreation Financial Assistance Program as an individual, or on behalf of an individual(s). One form may be submitted on behalf of multiple family members residing at the same address. Submission of this form does not guarantee approval into the program. You will be notified within 10 business days regarding the status of your application. Financial assistance is provided on a first come, first served basis.

A FUN Pass provides unlimited access to:

- The Fitness Centre and walking track.
- All swimming drop-in sessions, including open swims, lane swims and aquafit.
- All open gym sessions, including drop-in basketball, drop-in volleyball and drop-in pickleball.
- All kids' drop-in programs, including drop-in open gym, preschool drop-ins and playgroups.
- All fitness drop-in programs, including drop-in yoga, drop-in spin and drop-in HIIT.

Costs

As of January 1, 2023:

An Adult Monthly pass costs \$42.64 (including HST). Eligible applicants would pay \$15 (including HST), should their application be approved. A Child/Student/Senior Monthly pass costs \$28.81 (including HST). Eligible applicants would pay \$7.50 (including HST).

Eligibility Requirements

- Each applicant must be a resident of the City of Orillia.
- Applicants are required to re-apply each year.
- Individuals are subject to losing the Recreation Financial Assistance if membership is not being used for a consecutive three-month period. Usage is defined as attending the Orillia Recreation Centre a minimum of 6 times per month.

Required Documentation

Financial Assistance for a monthly FUN Pass will be provided based on financial need, as set out by the Low Income Cut-offs (LICOs) determined by Statistics Canada [Table 11-10-0241-01 Low income cut-offs \(LICOs\) before and after tax by community size and family size, in current dollars, for a population of 30,000-99,999.](#)

Applicants will be required to provide the following information to determine eligibility:

1. Documentation from residents and dependents applying for the program
2. Documentation to confirm residency in the City of Orillia
3. Documentation to confirm total family/household income
4. Documentation to confirm eligible dependents (if applicable)

Required Documentation

Documentation to confirm residency in the City of Orillia – Required for EACH adult, student* and senior.

**If a student lives in the same household as Applicant #1, they do not need to provide separate documentation. If they live at a different address than Applicant #1, or if they are applying for themselves, they must submit this documentation.*

- Valid Ontario Driver's License, or Ontario Photo Card, or;
- Recent utility bill displaying the applicant's name and residential address (within 3 months of application), or;
- Documentation confirming applicant's status at the residential property (Lease agreement or Property Tax Bill)

\$ Documentation to confirm total family/household income – Must show TOTAL household income.

- Tax Summary confirming the total household income (You might have to submit more than one Tax Summary in order to show the entire household income); AND,**
 - GST/HST Credit Notice; or,
 - ODSP Eligibility Card; or,
 - Ontario Works Notice; or,
 - CPP Disability Pension Statement; or,
 - Canada Customs and Revenue Agency Notice of Assessment Form (T451) showing net income/earning for all adults in the household; or,
 - Canada Child Benefit Notice; or,
 - Ontario Trillium Benefit Notice; or,
 - Old Age Security Pension Guaranteed Income Supplement

Documentation to confirm eligible dependents – Required for EACH dependent in the application who lives in the household

- GST/HST Credit Notice; or,
- Canada Child Benefit Notice; or,
- Ontario Trillium Benefit Notice
