



# Highlights from the Council Chamber

## **Council Committee Meeting – May 4, 2020**

Below is a snapshot of what Council Committee recommended at its meeting held on Monday, May 4, 2020. Please note: The wording below does not represent the exact wording of the motion and is meant as highlights.

**Please note that Council Committee recommendations are subject to Council ratification and can be pulled for discussion and change in direction at the Council meeting held on May 4, 2020 immediately following the Council Committee meeting.**

- A conditional Tax Increment Grant was authorized for property located at 4 King Street for 70% of the increased tax assessment at a maximum value of \$250,000 for a term not exceeding 5 years from the date of project completion, subject to the execution of a grant agreement which includes the conditions set out in the report. Staff was authorized to enter into an Undertaking Agreement with McLean & Dickey Ltd. which outlines the City of Orillia's intent to enter into a Tax Increment Grant Agreement, pending development of a legal agreement, by June 2021. An extension to the Development Charge Grant was authorized for property located at 144 Elgin Street previously granted through Report ED-19-05 to June 2022. The Director of Business Development and Communications was authorized to execute the grant agreements approved within the report.
