### Gathering Limit Restrictions

To help stop the spread of COVID-19, the Province of Ontario has lowered limits for unmonitored and private social gatherings across Ontario to a maximum of 10 people for an indoor event or gathering (previous limit of 50) or 25 people at an outdoor event or gathering (previous limit of 100). 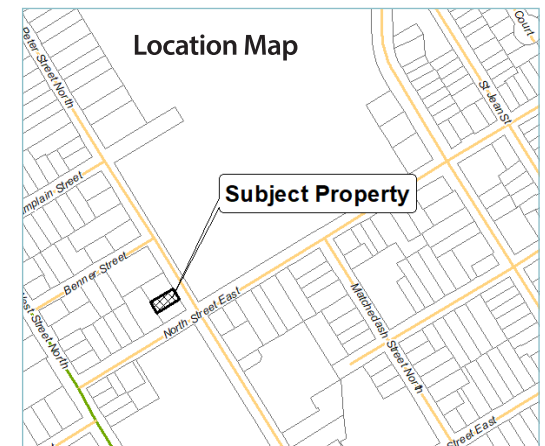
#### Purpose and Effect:

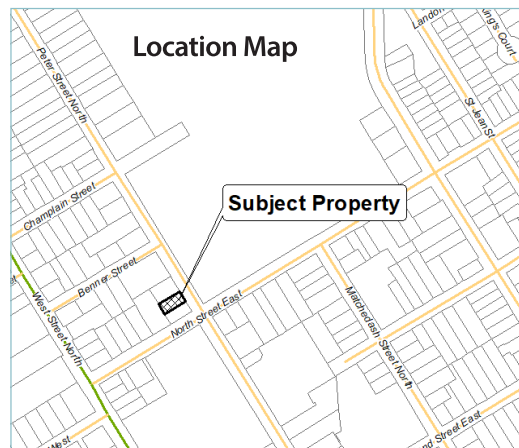
