

This guide has been provided to assist in summarizing the typical requirements to obtain a Demolition Permit to demolish a building in the City of Orillia. Additional information may be required as needed depending on the application type and individual circumstances.

Required Application Forms

* Not required for applications submitted through the public portal.



Required Drawings and Information

- General Site Plan showing location of the building to be demolished (or photos)
- Professional engineer overview required if the building > 600m²

Vermin Control Requirements

A completed [Vermin Control Review Form](#) or A Site Inspection Clearance Certificate issued by an Ontario Licensed Exterminator stating that the entire interior/exterior of the site has been inspected and is free of any infestation of rodents and other vermin that may cause negative impacts to the surrounding community is required for **non-residential** demolition permits.

Demolition Permit Fees

Payment of Demolition Permit fees is required when you submit your Demolition Permit Application.

Demolition Permit Fees may be paid by cash, cheque, debit, or credit card. *Credit card payments are accepted online only. A 2.4% convenience fee applies to credit card payments.*
